Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Saturday, February 5th. Expect Partly Cloudy Skies with Temps will be warming into the upper 40's – Low 50's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds and possible Ridge Gusts up to 55mph and up to 75mph in the afternoon that may hamper the operation of upper mountain lifts. So, Lift Operation will be Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress in Layers with your Windproof Jacket or a Shell. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles. Don't forget to use Sunscreen when the sun is out. Surface conditions are Variable with and Machine Groomed & Skier Rider Packed Powder and some area of Firm Packed Snow Off-Piste. Ski and Ride with Care. Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles – Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
