Winter Weather Advisory expires at 8am this morning but continued snow showers are expected through out the day. Temperatures getting into the High 30's on the slope with Light to Moderate Winds and Stronger Ridge Gusts up to 65 mph, that may affected the operation of upper mountain lifts. — So, be aware or Call Ahead. Dress in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
