Expect Cloudy Skies with Chance of Rain and Snow above 8000. Temperatures into the Mid 40's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds and Stronger Gusty Winds 70 to 100mph over the Ridge Tops. Upper Mountain Lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. A Winter Weather Advisory goes into effect this evening. Dress in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
