Expect Snow Showers to continue today with Temperatures getting into the mid 20's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds and Ridge Gusts up to 50mph that could hamper the operation of upper mountain lifts. So. Lifts will Operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress warm, in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles / Face Gaiter & Warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
