Winter Storm Warning remains in effect thru Friday mid morning... Expect Snow, Heavy at Times with Temperature in the upper 20's on the slopes and Moderate to Strong Gusty Winds with Ridge Gusts 95-110mph. Lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress warm, in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles / Face Gaiter & Warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Fresh Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
