Expect Mostly Cloudy Skies and Scattered Snow Showers with temperatures into the mid 30's on the Slopes. Light to Moderate Winds with Ridge Gusts 55 to 75 mph could affect the operation of Upper Mountain Lifts. So lifts again will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress warm, in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles & Warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
