Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Sunday, March 6th. A Winter Weather Advisory is posted till 10am this morning for Snow and Rain in the Morning. 4-6" expected to fall above 7000 feet. Temps getting into the mid 30's on the slopes with Light to Moderate Winds and possible Ridge Gusts to 70mph decreasing to 55mph in the afternoon. so lift operations will be Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
