Good Morning, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders. If you're visiting, Welcome to Lake Tahoe. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Tuesday, April 5th. A change in weather coming... Expect Partly Cloudy Skies in the morning...then Mostly Cloudy with isolated showers in the afternoon. Snow level 8500 feet. Temps into the mid 50's on the Slopes. Light to Moderate Winds with Ridge Gusts up to 60 mph may hamper the operation of upper mountain Lifts in the afternoon. Dress in Layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket or Shell; Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles and don't forget the Sunscreen when the sun is out. Surface conditions are Spring Conditions - Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Firm Packed Snow - Softening. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
