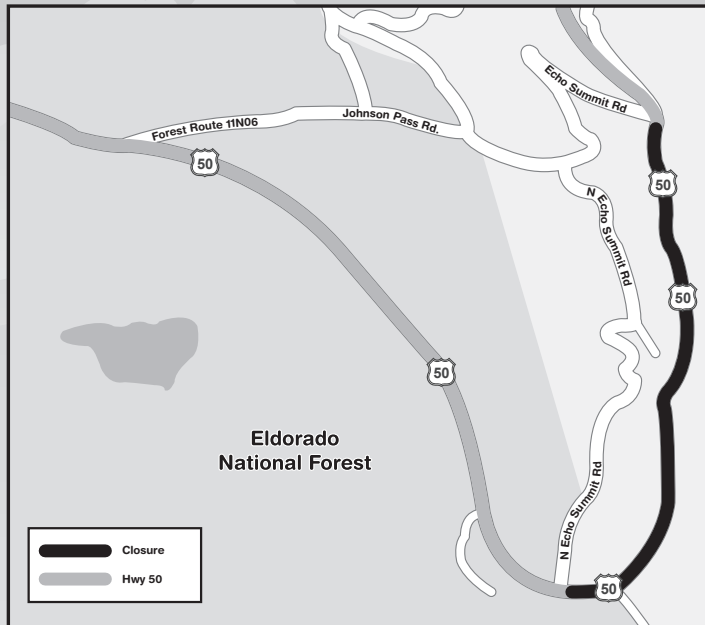


U.S. HWY 50 CLOSURE AT ECHO SUMMIT

Passes available to local residents to use Johnson Pass Road



Caltrans will close U.S. Hwy 50 at Echo Summit for two weeks beginning sometime in May (weather permitting) to replace the rock wall barrier. Johnson Pass Road will be available on a limited basis to local residents needing to travel over the summit to go to and from work or school only.

Caltrans will issue Johnson Pass Road "PASSES" from 8 A.M. to 6 P.M. on the following Wednesdays and Thursdays: April 21, 27, 28 and May 4, 5 at:
