The Final Day of the season for my Radio Ski Reports and Final Day for many Resorts. So, Get Out and Get your Last Turns In. Weather Still Unsettled, So, Expect Cloudy Skies, Rain & Snow Likely with Snow Level at 6500 Feet. Temperatures in to the Low 40's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds and Stronger Ridge Gusts up to 65 Mph in the afternoon that may affect Upper Mountain Lifts. Dress in layers with your Windproof-Waterproof Jacket; Take a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles. Surface conditions are Variable with Fresh Snow and Spring Conditions - Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Firm Packed Snow – all Softening with day-time temperatures. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
