Temps in to the mid 30's on the Slopes and Light to Moderate Winds with Stronger Ridge Gusts up to 70mph, that may affect the operation of upper-mountain Lifts. So Lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress Warm, in Layers with your Windproof – Waterproof Jacket; Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety. Also, wear Good Goggles & Warm Gloves. Surface conditions are Spring Conditions - Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Firm Packed Snow - Softening. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles. Always Ski or Ride with a Buddy if you go Off-Piste and Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only.
