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# El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday May 15 -21, 2011

# **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**State Route 28**(Placer County) in Kings Beach: Work continues on a \$46 million environmental improvement project to reconstruct drainage facilities and improve the road surface. Completion is expected in the fall of 2011.

- **U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County in South Lake Tahoe: Work has begun on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2013.
- **U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) Echo Summit: Work will begin on a \$1.9 million project to reconstruct rock wall barriers and replace drainage on U.S Highway 50 near the Echo Summit. The project is funded in part by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). #### May 11 - 24

**U. S. 50 (El Dorado County)** from Echo Summit Road to Chiapa Drive: Motorists can expect the roadway **closed May 11 – 24.** A signed detour is available. A contractor is scheduled to replace an aging rock wall.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work has resumed on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected in the fall of 2011.

## May 15 - 21

- **U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Placerville Drive to Missouri Flat Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday. A Contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.
- **U. S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work continues on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County. Completion is expected in August of 2011.

### May 16 - 21

**U. S. Highway 50** between El Dorado/Sacramento County line and Cambridge Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Saturday (8 a.m. Friday and Saturday).** A contractor is scheduled for drainage work.

**State Route 89** (El Dorado County) from El Dorado County between the Alpine County line and U.S. Highway 50: Work continues on a \$25 million project to widen the shoulders to 4-foot minimum, construct curb and gutters, and rehabilitate and construct new drainage facilities. This project allows for roadway runoff to be directed to treatment collection facilities including infiltration swales, rock energy dissipaters and sand collection traps/vaults. Completion is expected in fall of 2011. **Project is currently in winter suspension.** 

#### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**State Route 28** (Placer County) from Tahoe State Park to Agate Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping work.

**State Route 28** (Placer County) from Agate Road to Estates Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

**State Route 28** (Placer County) from Stag Drive to Junction State Route 267 (Kings Beach): Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do permit work.

**State Route 49** (El Dorado / Placer County) from Junction State Route 193 (Cool) to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

- **U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Sly Park Road to Fresh Pond: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for saw cutting and drainage work.
- **U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from the South Fork of the American River to Pyramid Creek: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.
- **U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Placerville Drive to Missouri Flat Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures **from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday.** A Contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

**State Route 89** (El Dorado County) from Bliss State Park to Ring Road: Motorists can expect a one-way traffic control from **7:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for guardrail repair.

County **State Route 193** (El Dorado) from South Fork American River Bridge to the Junction at State Route 49: Motorists can expect north and southbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

County **State Route 193** (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to the Junction at State Route 49: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Tuesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do permit work.

**State Route 267** (Placer County) from Northstar Drive to the Brockway Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled for excavation work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
