May 8 - May 14, 2011

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

On Interstate 80, the east and westbound Donner Rest Areas will be closed through **November 1**. A contractor is scheduled to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. **Work will resume June 2011**.

Interstate 80(Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III construction project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in Fall 2011.

May 8 - May 14

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Soda Springs to Donner Park Overcrossing: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane closures from 6:00 a.m. to 10 a.m. Monday and midnight to 11:59 (10 a.m. Friday) Tuesday through Friday.

Interstate 80 (Nevada/Sierra Counties) Eastbound from Truckee River Bridge to State Line: Work has begun on a \$1.7 million concrete barrier project, along Interstate 80, east of Truckee. The project will replace existing guardrail with permanent concrete barrier at seven locations. Work on the project will be completed by June 30, 2011.

May 8 - May 14

Interstate 80 (Nevada/Sierra Counties) from Truckee River Bridge to Nevada State Line: Motorists can expect eastbound lane closures and minimal delays from 5:00 a.m. Monday through 1:00 p.m. Thursday. A contractor is installing concrete barrier at various locations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Yuba County Line to junction of Interstate 80: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for crack seal operation.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Placer County Line to Yuba County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Lemon Canyon/Campbell Hot Springs to Hill Street: Motorists can expect north and southbound lane closures from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans maintenance crew is scheduled for crack seal operation.

State Route 49 (Yuba/Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Placer County Line to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Yuba Gap to Cisco Grove: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday (6:00 a. m. to 10:00 a.m. Friday). A contractor is scheduled for survey and striping and marking work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Interstate 80/State Route 193 Separator to Gold Run: Motorists can expect intermittent eastbound lane closures from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Bell Road: Motorists can expect full eastbound offramp closure from **8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for guardrail and electrical street light repair.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Nyack to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (10:00 a.m. Friday)

Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled for paving and electrical work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Placer County Line to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans maintenance crew is scheduled for guardrail repair.

Interstate 80 (Placer/Nevada Counties) from Cisco Grove to Separate Align: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 6:00 a.m. (10:00 a.m. Friday) to 6:00 p.m Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled for electrical and striping/marking work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Main Street to Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Bear River Bridge to Auburn Street: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane closures from **8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for brush clearing.
