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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday October 2 – October 8, 2011

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Rest Areas (Nevada County) Work continues to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. Work is expected to be completed on the westbound rest area by mid-summer 2011. Expected completion for the eastbound rest area is late fall 2011.

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012.

<u>October 3 - 5</u>

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Pingree Road to Cornette Way: Motorists can expect various north and southbound lanes closed from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. Motorists are also advised to reduce speed and be alert for modified lane and intersection configurations. A contractor is scheduled for miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.





<u>October 3 - 7</u>

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Cisco Grove to Hampshire Road Road: Motorists can a single, narrow eastbound lane and delays of up to 20 minutes 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled for paving.

September 26 - October 6

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Yuba Gap interchange: motorists can expect the Yuba Gap off-ramp to eastbound I-80 closed through Thursday, October 6. A detour is available. This ramp is under reconstruction.

<u>September 26 – October 7</u>

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Yuba Gap interchange: motorists can expect the Yuba Gap on-ramp to eastbound I-80 closed through Friday, October 7. A detour is available. This ramp is under reconstruction.

September 30 - October 10

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the State Route 20 interchange: motorists can expect the eastbound off-ramp to State Route 20 closed through Monday, October 10. A detour is available. This ramp is under reconstruction.

September 30 - October 15

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Eagle Lakes Road interchange: Motorists can expect the eastbound Eagle Lakes Road on and off-ramps **closed until Friday, October 15.** A detour is available. These ramps are under reconstruction.

October 3 - 8

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the Interstate 80 Junction: Motorists can expect Intermittent east and westbound lane and ramp closures from 5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Saturday (Motorists can expect up to 15 minute delays) A contractor is scheduled for bridge work.





Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III Project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in fall 2011.

October 3 - 7

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Castle Peak to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect intermittent closures of the #2 eastbound lane from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled for paving operations

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Castle Peak and Donner Lake interchanges. Motorist can expect the eastbound on-ramp at Castle Peak and the eastbound off-ramp to Donner Lake closed through October 14 for reconstruction.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Deadman's Flat to Penn Valley Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled for miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from the State Route 193 junction to the Placer/Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various

locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Downieville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6:45 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Kingvale to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Agriculture Inspection Station to the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled for striping and paving.







Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the State Route 89 South interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent closures of the westbound on and off-ramp from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday. A detour is available. A contractor is scheduled for bridge construction.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Trout Creek to the West Truckee undercrossing: Motorists can expect the #2 eastbound lane closed from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled for bridge construction.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Central Truckee Interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent closures of westbound on and off-ramps from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday. Contractors are scheduled for paving, curb and gutter work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Newcastle to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Ophir Road to Lincoln Way: Motorists can expect various lane and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled for guardrail and drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Niels Road and Placer Hills Road: Motorists can expect traffic controls on the overcrossings from 1 a.m. on Sunday through 11 p.m. on Saturday. A contractor is scheduled for bridge maintenance.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Applegate to east of Colfax: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **7 p.m. To 10 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.** A contactor is scheduled for a fog seal operation.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Yuba Gap to Kingvale: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Interstate 80 to Rainbow Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled for utility work.







State Route 89 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Rainbow Road to Webber Lake: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to clear ditches.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Colfax to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.
