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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday October 16 – October 22, 2011

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Rest Areas (Nevada County) Work continues to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. Work is expected to be completed on November 15.

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. <u>No traffic</u> <u>interfering work is scheduled.</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

October 17 - 21

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Cisco Grove to Hampshire Rock: Motorists can a single, narrow eastbound lane and delays of up to 20 minutes **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled for paving.







September 29 – October 20

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Eagle Lake interchange: motorists can expect the on and off-ramps connecting to eastbound Interstate 80 **closed through Thursday, October 20**. A detour is available. The ramps are under reconstruction.

October 17 – October 20

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Yuba Gap interchange: motorists can expect the Yuba Gap on-ramp to eastbound I-80 closed **Monday, October 17 through Thursday, October 20**. A detour is available. This ramp is under reconstruction.

September 30 – October 29

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the State Route 20 interchange: motorists can expect the State Route 20 on-ramp to eastbound Interstate 80 closed **through Saturday, October 29.** A detour is available. This ramp is under reconstruction.

October 19

State Route 20 (Nevada County) at the Interstate 80: Motorists can expect a full highway closure from 5 p.m. to 11 a.m. Wednesday (Motorists can expect up to 15 minute delays). A detour will be available. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III Project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaying the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in early winter 2011. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Yuba County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans Maintenance crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.







State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from the State Route 193 junction to the Placer/Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Downieville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Donner Lake undercrossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Kingvale to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Agriculture Inspection Station to the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled for striping.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from State Route 89 South to West Truckee: Motorists can expect intermittent lane and ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday.** Detours are available. A contractor is scheduled for bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Farad to Boca: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 lane closed from **7:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Long Ravine under-crossing to Applegate: Motorists can expect intermittent full-highway closures from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday and Tuesday**. Union Pacific is scheduled to do bridge work. Closures will not exceed 15 minutes at a time.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Neils Road to Illinoistown: Motorists can expect traffic controls on the overcrossings from **1 a.m. on Sunday through 11 p.m. on Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled for bridge maintenance.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Yuba Gap to Kingvale: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.







State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sierraville to Sattley: Motorists can expect oneway traffic control from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Rainbow Road to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Auburn Street to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
