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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday October 23 – October 29, 2011

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Rest Areas (Nevada County) Work continues to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. Work is expected to be completed on November 15.

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. <u>No traffic</u> <u>interfering work is scheduled.</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

October 24 - 28

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Cisco Grove to Hampshire Rock: Motorists can expect a single, narrow eastbound lane and delays of up to 20 minutes from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving.







<u> October 17 – October 28</u>

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the Eagle Lake interchange: Motorists can expect the on and off-ramps connecting to eastbound Interstate 80 **closed through Friday, October 28**. A detour is available. The ramps are under reconstruction.

September 30 – October 29

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the State Route 20 interchange: Motorists can expect the State Route 20 on and off-ramps connecting to eastbound Interstate 80 closed **through Saturday**, **October 29**. A detour is available. The ramps are under reconstruction.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III Project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in early winter 2011. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Yuba County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to State Route 174: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to construct a sidewalk.

State Route 20 (Placer County) from the Bear River to Lake Spaulding Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do overhead utility work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Bear River: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 7 a.m. to
4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.







State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Little Deer Drive to Pekolee Road: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #1 lanes closed from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday and Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do roadway repairs.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to the Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Ophir Road to State Route 174: Motorists can expect various intermittent east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping operations.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures in various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from West Paoli Lane to the Nevada County Line:
Motorists can expect intermittent lane and ramp closures in various locations from
7 a.m. to 4 p.m. (noon Friday) Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge repairs.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Applegate to Heather Glenn: Motorists can expect intermittent lane and ramp closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping work. Detours will be available.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Neils Road to Illinoistown: Motorists can expect traffic controls on the overcrossings from **1 a.m. Sunday through 11 p.m. Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge maintenance.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Donner Lake undercrossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lanes closed from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at Soda Springs: Motorists can expect the eastbound off-ramp closed from **October 24 to November 4**. A contractor is scheduled to reconstruct the ramp.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Yuba Gap to Kingvale: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.







Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Agriculture Inspection Station to the Truckee River Bridge: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do striping.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from State Route 89 South to Trout Creek: Motorists can expect intermittent lane and ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. (12 noon on Friday) Monday through Friday.** Detours are available. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge to Floriston: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 lane closed from **7:15 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Alder Drive to Prosser Hill Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Rainbow Road to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 89 (Sierra and Nevada Counties) at Sagehen Creek: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do shoulder backing.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sierraville to Sattley: Motorists can expect the northbound #1 lane closed from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping operations.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from Auburn Street to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Skyview Lane to the Newcastle Tunnel: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Thursday and Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do overhead utility work.







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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
