SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday November 6 – November 12, 2011

Most traffic interfering work will be limited from Friday, November 11 through Sunday, November 13 for the Veterans Day Holiday.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Rest Areas (Nevada County) Work continues to replace both rest areas. When this \$3.4 million project is complete, the facilities and parking will be upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and will be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. Work is expected to be completed on November 15.

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

November 7 – November 10

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Cisco Grove to Hampshire Rock: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from





5 a.m. to 6 p.m. (12 noon on Thursday) Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do paving, striping, guardrail and median work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Summit to Donner Lake: Work continues on the \$71 million Donner III Project to improve Interstate 80. Work includes repaving the existing roadway with Portland Cement Concrete, reconstructing failed sections of roadway, adding new drainage systems, upgrading existing drainage systems and construction of a new sediment/debris collection system. Completion is expected in early winter 2011.

November 7 – November 11

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Castle Peak to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **12:01 a.m. Monday through 10 a.m. on Friday.** A contractor is scheduled for striping operations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to State Route 174: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 lane closed from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to construct a sidewalk.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Yuba County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Penn Valley Drive to Ponderosa Way: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #1 lanes closed from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday and Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to install guardrail.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Bear River: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Yuba County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch cleaning.





State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to the Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch cleaning.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at State Route 174: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do a bridge inspection.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures in various locations from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from State Route 89 South to Trout Creek: Motorists can expect intermittent lane and ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. Detours are available. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sierraville to Sattley: Motorists can expect the northbound #1 lane closed from **8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping operations.

State Route 174 (Nevada County) from the Bear River to Auburn Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 3p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Skyview Lane to the Newcastle tunnel undercrossing: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do permit work.
