## **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

Interstate 80 Donner Safety Roadside Rest Areas (Nevada County) This \$12.5 million project is complete, the facilities have been upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. The eastbound SRRA parking lot will be complete in spring of 2012.

**State Highway 49** (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. **Project is in winter suspension.** 

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. <a href="Project is in winter suspension.">Project is in winter suspension.</a>

**State Route 49** (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Yuba Pass Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Pass Road to the Sierra County line: Motorists can expect the #2 eastbound lane closed from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Sierra County line to Donner Pass Road: Motorists can expect the #2 westbound lane closed from 8:15 a.m. to 11:59 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do slide removal.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) between State Route 193 and Gold Run Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**State Route 174** (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Interstate 80 to State Route 49: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Friday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for miscellaneous maintenance work.







**State Route 267** (Placer County) from Northstar Drive to Martis Peak Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled for drainage cleaning.
