## SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday April 15 – April 21, 2012

# **Special Event**

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Secret Town Road to State Route 174: Motorists can expect a full westbound highway closure from 5:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Tuesday. Multiple Caltrans Maintenance crews are scheduled to do a combined maintenance operation on the three-mile grade. Commercial vehicles will be detoured at State Route 20 and passenger vehicles will be detoured at Secret Town Road.

#### LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Safety Roadside Rest Areas (Nevada County) This \$12.5 million project is complete, the facilities have been upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. The eastbound SRRA parking lot will be complete in spring of 2012.

**State Highway 49** (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. **Project is in winter suspension.** 

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.







#### **April 16 - April 20**

On Interstate 80 from State Route 20 to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **midnight Monday through 5 a.m.**Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do striping operations.

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from Penn Valley Drive to Brighton Street: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **5 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

**State Route 20** (Nevada County) from Rex Reservoir to Brighton Street: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.
