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El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday May 6 – May 12, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

May 6 - May 12

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 8 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail.



U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

May 6 - May 12

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013.

May 7- May 11

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Trout Creek Bridge to Los Angeles Boulevard: Motorists can expect eastbound lane restrictions from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do curb, gutter and sidewalk work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Lardin Way to Ridgewood Road: Motorists can expect intermittent controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Granite Road to National Avenue: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Park Lane to Chipmunk Street: Motorists can expect intermittent controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do curb, gutter, sidewalk and utility work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from





7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Greenstone Road undercrossing to Missouri Flat Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect #1 eastbound lane restrictions from 6 p.m. to 8 a.m. Saturday through Monday. A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday (11 a.m. Friday).** A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from South Fork American River to Pyramid Creek: Motorists can expect #1 eastbound lane restrictions from **8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage cleaning.

State Route 193 (El Dorado County) from Ricci Road to Graybar Mine Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **midnight to 11:59 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Brockway Summit to Northstar Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **midnight Sunday through noon Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
