El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday May 20 – May 26, 2012

Most traffic interfering work will be limited Friday, May 25 through Monday, May 28 due to the Memorial Day Holiday.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

<u> May 20 - May 25</u>

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **5 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail.





U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

<u> May 20 – May 25</u>

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013. No traffic-interfering work is scheduled.

SPECIAL EVENT

State Route 49 and 193 (El Dorado) Motorists are asked to be cautious of the bicyclist and can expect traffic controls starting at **6:30 a.m. on Sunday.** The Motherlode Century Bicycle Club is holding a bicycle event on portions of Highways 49 and 193 in El Dorado County.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Lardin Way to Ridgewood Road: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Ridgewood Road to Sahara Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.





State Route 28 (Placer County) from Granite Road to Beach Avenue: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Beach Avenue to Park Lane Street: Motorists can expect intermittent lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do curb, gutter, sidewalk and utility work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Carson Creek Bridge to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect #1 east and westbound lane restrictions from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Greenstone Road undercrossing to Missouri Flat Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect #2 eastbound lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation and install guardrail for the Animal undercrossing project.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing (Cedar Grove) to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from South Fork American River to Pyramid Creek: Motorists can expect #1 eastbound lane restrictions from **8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage cleaning.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from River Drive to Winnemucca Avenue: Motorist can expect #2 lane and shoulder lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do core drilling work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Fremont Avenue to the Nevada State line: Motorists can expect east and westbound intermittent #2 lane closures from
7 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday). A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Spruce Avenue to Grimsel Pass Road: Motorists can expect #1 lane north and southbound lane restrictions from **5:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do crack sealing roadwork.





State Route 193 (El Dorado County) from Cherry Acres road to Rock Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Brockway Summit to Northstar Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls with up to 10 minute delays from **10 p.m. Sunday through to 2 p.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
