LONG-TERM PROJECTS

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and

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ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

May 29 – June 2

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013. **No traffic-interfering work is scheduled.**

SPECIAL EVENT

U.S. Highway 50, State Route 89 and 28 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) Motorists can expect lane restrictions and minimal delays from **6:30 a.m. on Sunday, June 3**. The annual “America’s Most Beautiful Bike Ride” around Lake Tahoe. Please watch for bicyclist while sharing the road.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Lardin Way to Ridgewood Road: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Park Lane to Chipmunk Street: Motorists can expect intermittent westbound lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday**

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through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do curb, gutter, sidewalk and utility work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Carson Creek Bridge to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect #1 east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **8 p.m. to 8 a.m. Wednesday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail and do roadway excavation.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Greenstone Road undercrossing to Missouri Flat Road overcrossing: Motorists can expect #2 eastbound lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction install guardrail.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing (Cedar Grove) to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Friday (11 a.m. Friday).** A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sand Flat Campground to (Sierra at Tahoe) Sierra Ski Ranch Road: Motorists can expect right shoulder work from **5 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday through Friday (noon Friday).** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Elizabeth Drive to Timberland Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Friday (noon Friday).** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Tan tavern / Granlibakken to Grand Avenue: Motorists can expect #1 north and southbound lane restrictions from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday through Friday (noon Friday).** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Brockway Summit to Northstar Drive: Motorists can expect #1 north and southbound restrictions with up to 10 minute delays from **6 p.m. to 1 p.m. Tuesday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday).** A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
