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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday May 6 – May 12, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 Donner Safety Roadside Rest Areas (Nevada County) This \$12.5 million project is complete, the facilities have been upgraded to meet the demands of the more than three million annual visitors and is compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act standards. The eastbound SRRA parking lot will be complete in spring of 2012. <u>No traffic interfering work is scheduled.</u>

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has begun on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012. <u>Project is in winter</u> <u>suspension.</u>

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

<u> May 7 – May 11</u>

On Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **midnight Monday through 5 a.m. Friday**. Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-foot lane in each direction. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.





SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Indian Springs Road to Squirrel Creek Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to Washington Street: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Education Street to Rock Creek Road: Motorists can expect the southbound #2 lane closed from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to the Yuba Pass
Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from
6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Shangri-La to Gold Lake Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 65 to Newcastle Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Hallborn Road under-crossing to the east Auburn over-head: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sunday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.





Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Colfax to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from the Placer County line to the Nevada/California state line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Donner Lake under-crossing to the Placer County line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Donner Park over-crossing and the Fibreboard under-crossing: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Sierra County line to Observation Point: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 lane closed from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road to Klondike Flat Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Skyview Lane to Fowler Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do grinding and paving.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.





Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
