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El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday June 3 – June 9, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

June 3 - 9

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail.

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U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

June 3 - 9

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013.

June 3 - 9

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Trout Creek Bridge to Los Angeles Boulevard: Motorists can expect #1 intermittent eastbound lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through (11 a.m. Friday) Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

SPECIAL EVENT

U.S. Highway 50, State Route 89 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) Motorists can expect lane restrictions and minimal delays from **7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Sunday, June 9**. The annual "De Celle Memorial Lake Tahoe Relay Race around Lake Tahoe. Please watch for runners while sharing the road.

U. S. Highway 50, westbound from Zephyr Cove, Nevada to Placerville: Motorists can expect minimal delays from **June 3 - 9**. The annual "Highway 50 Association Wagon Train" procession will be traveling on the far right side of the road. Please be cautious of the wagons while sharing the roadway.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado / Placer County) from Junction State Route 193 (Cool) to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Carson Creek Bridge to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect #1 east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Wednesday through Saturday (Saturday 9 a.m.)**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail and do roadway excavation.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Greenstone Road undercrossing to Placerville Drive overcrossing (Forni Road / Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect interment#1,#2 east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation, highway construction and guardrail work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing (Cedar Grove) to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday (11 a.m. Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from 34 Mile Stone Road to Pyramid Creek Tract: Motorists can expect right shoulder work from **Midnight 12 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. to midnight 12 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.





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State Route 89 (Placer County) from Chambers Lodge to Park Avenue: Motorists can expect #1 north and southbound lane restrictions from **6 a.m. to 1 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

State Route 193 (El Dorado County) from Ricci Road to Garden Valley Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Skyview Lane to Old State Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Brockway Summit to Northstar Drive: Motorists can expect #1 north and southbound restrictions with up to 10 minute delays from **6 p.m. to 1 p.m. Sunday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to pave the shoulders and drainage work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
