## **El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday June 10 – June 16, 2012**

### **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**U. S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

#### **June 10 - 16**

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

### June 10 - 16

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**State Route 28** (Placer County) from Lardin Way to Ridgewood Road: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

**State Route 28** (Placer County) from Bear Street and Brook Street to Park Lane: Motorists can expect intermittent westbound lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do sewer and paving work.

**State Route 49** (El Dorado / Placer County) from Junction State Route 193 (Cool) to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Carson Creek Bridge to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect #1 east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday (Saturday 10 a.m.)**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail and do roadway excavation.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Greenstone Road undercrossing to Placerville Drive overcrossing (Forni Road / Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect intermentent#1,#2 east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do roadway excavation, highway construction and guardrail work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing (Cedar Grove) to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions and **ramp closures** from **4:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Monday through Friday (11 a.m. Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work. (Detours will be posted)

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from 34 Mile Stone Road to Pyramid Creek Tract: Motorists can expect right shoulder work from **Midnight 12 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. to midnight 12 p.m. Monday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday)**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from River Drive to Winnemucca Avenue: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 lane and right shoulder work from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (1 p.m. Friday)**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do core drilling work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Frog Pond to South Lake Tahoe Air Port Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

**State Route 89** (Placer County) from Cherry Street to Grimsel Pass Road: Motorists can one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**State Route 89** (Placer County) from Tamarack Lane to Sequoia Avenue: Motorists can expect #1 east and westbound lane restrictions from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday and Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**State Route 193** (El Dorado County) from Bear Creek Road to Garden Valley Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

**State Route 267** (Placer County) from Northstar Drive to Brockway Summit: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control with up to 10 minute delays from **6 p.m. to 3 p.m.**
