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El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday June 24– June 30, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

June 24 - 30

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail and do grinding and paving work.

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U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

June 24 - 30

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013.

June 24 - 30

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Trout Creek to Lake View Avenue: Motorists can expect #2 intermittent eastbound lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through (11 a.m. Friday) Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Fremont Avenue to Fairway Avenue: Motorists can expect #2 intermittent east and westbound lane restrictions from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through (11 a.m. Friday) Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

SPECIAL EVENT

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Highway 50 at Bedford Avenue to Main Street in Placerville: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane closures from **5 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Saturday, June 30**. The “Bell Tower Brewfest” event will be held on Main Street in Placerville. Please watch for pedestrians while sharing the road in the area.





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SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Lardin Way to Ridgewood Road: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound #1 lane restrictions from **8:00 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado County) from Riverwood Drive South to Riverwood Drive North: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado / Placer Counties) from Junction State Route 193 (Cool) to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Carson Creek Bridge to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect #1 east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Saturday (Saturday 10 a.m.)**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail and do roadway excavation, grinding and paving.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing (Cedar Grove) to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions and **ramp closures** from **6 a.m. to 7p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sand Flat Campground to 34 Mile Stone Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound left and right shoulder work from **4 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday (noon Friday)**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Wrights lake Road to Forni Tract: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **6:00 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday (10a.m. Thursday and Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

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U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Pyramid Creek Tract: Motorists can expect east and westbound right shoulder work from **4 a.m. to 10 a.m. Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Sawmill Road to South Lake Tahoe Air Port Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

State Route 89 (El Dorado County) from the U.S. Highway 50 Junction (The “Y”) to West Way: Motorists can expect the #1, #2 north and southbound restrictions from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

State Route 89 (El Dorado County) from Eagle Falls Campground to General Creek State Park: Motorists can expect the #1 north and southbound restrictions from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Grimsel Pass Road to Oak Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. (additional time 7:30 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday) Monday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Truckee River Bridge to Montreal Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch cleaning.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Brockway Summit to Northstar Drive to: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control with up to 10 minute delays from **6 p.m. to 1 a.m. Sunday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday)**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from Camelian Byrd to National Avenue: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control with up to 10 minute delays from **9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday and Tuesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guardrail repair.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

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Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
