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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday

June 3 – June 9, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012.

June 4 – June 8

On Highway 49 from Little Valley Road to Cornette Way: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

June 4 – June 9

On Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various east and westbound ramp closures **Monday through Saturday**. **Detours will be available and no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.





June 4 – June 8

On Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **midnight Monday through 5 a.m. Friday**. **Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-foot lane in each direction.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Yuba County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do spray operations.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the Squirrel Creek Bridge to the Idaho-Maryland Road under-crossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical and guardrail work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to Broad Street: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to State Route 174: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do sidewalk, curb and gutter work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Middle Fork Yuba River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Education Street to Rock Creek Road: Motorists can expect the north and southbound #2 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.





State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Sun Shadow Circle to N. Sidehill Viaduct: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 11 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Coyoteville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Downieville to Sierra City: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. Monday through 7 p.m. Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 65 to Newcastle: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Bowman Road in Auburn: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Gold Run to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Hampshire Rock to Kingvale: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday and Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Pass Road to Highway 89 south: Motorists can expect various eastbound lanes closed from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Kingvale to the Nevada State line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Donner Park over-crossing to the Overland Trail under-crossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp





closures from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 89 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Sagehen Creek to Webber Lake/Cottonwood Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from State Route 20 to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. from 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Skyview Lane to Old State Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
