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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday June 24 – June 30, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right-turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012.

<u>June 25– June 28</u>

On Highway 49 from Little Valley Road to Cornette Way: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

<u>June 26 – July 1</u>

On westbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various westbound lane and ramp closures from 11 p.m. Tuesday through 9 a.m. Sunday.

<u>Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-foot lane in each</u>

<u>direction</u>. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.





June 25 - June 29

On eastbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane closures from midnight Monday through 11 a.m. Friday. <u>Motorists</u> can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-foot lane in each direction. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

June 28

On eastbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect to be shifted into a new lane configuration on **Thursday**. The shift is necessary to allow for additional work on the eastbound lanes.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Cattle Drive to Penn Valley Drive/Rough & Ready Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous contruction work.

State Route 49 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from State Interstate 80 to Nevada City: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Mill Street to Uren Street: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Golden Chain Drive to the Yuba County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Education Street to Rock Creek Road: Motorists can expect the southbound #2 lanes closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (Yuba and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Nevada Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Donner Lake undercrossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Donner Park over-crossing to the Overland Trail under-crossing: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures





from **6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Donner Park over-crossing to the Truckee River: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 89 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from the Truckee River Bridge to Montreal Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to Sierraville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Placer County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. from 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.
