SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday

July 8 – July 14, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012.

July 9 – July 13

On Highway 49 from Little Valley Road to Cornette Way: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled for paving work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

July 8 – 14

On westbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various westbound lane and ramp closures from **11 p.m. Tuesday through 9 a.m. Sunday**. **Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-foot lane in each direction.** A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

On eastbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane closures from **midnight Monday through 11 a.m. Friday**. **Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-foot lane in each direction.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Mooney Flat Road to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled for shoulder work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Pleasant Valley Road to Penn Valley Road : Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled for guardrail work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Dorsey Drive to the State Route 174 Junction: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled for guardrail work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Pearl Street to the Yuba Pass: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled for paving work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Truckee to Floriston: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **6 p.m. Monday through 9 a.m.**





Friday. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Truckee River Bridge to the California Agriculture Inspection Station: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled for paving work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Newcastle to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Gold Run to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from the Truckee River Bridge to Cabin Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 4:30 Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to clear ditches.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Old Truckee Road to Sierraville: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Placer County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. from 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Summer Star/Ames Lane to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A utility crew is scheduled for tree work.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
