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## **El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday July 8 – July 14, 2012**

### **LONG-TERM PROJECTS**

**U. S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work resumes on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County to add bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County.

**July 8 - 13**





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U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Bass Lake undercrossing to Shingle Springs Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 9 a.m. Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) U.S. 50/Missouri Flat Interchange Improvements: Work resumes on a \$40.5 million project. The project includes: reconfiguration to a four-lane interchange, auxiliary lanes between the interchange and the Forni Road/Western Placerville Drive Interchange; widening, addition of a bike/pedestrian facility between Missouri Flat Road and Placerville Drive. Completion is expected 2012.

## July 8 - 13

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Missouri Flat Road to Placerville Drive (Forni Road/ Fairgrounds): Motorists can expect east and westbound lane restrictions and ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do highway construction.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work resumes on a \$40.6 million project to widen shoulders, construct new sidewalks, add bike lanes, install new roadside drainage systems and improve signal operations from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Blvd. Completion is expected in 2012-2013.

## July 9 - 13

**U. S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Tulare Avenue / Al Tahoe to Tallac Avenue: Motorists can expect #2 intermittent eastbound lane restrictions from **6 a.m. to (noon) 12 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

**U. S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Fremont Avenue to Ham Road: Motorists can expect #2 eastbound lane and right shoulder restrictions from **8 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

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### SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

**State Route 49** (El Dorado County) from Chapel Street Pacific Street: Motorists can expect right shoulder work from **6 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday and Tuesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**State Route 49** (El Dorado County) from Riverwood Drive South to Riverwood Drive North: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls work from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

**State Route 49** (El Dorado / Placer County) from Junction State Route 193 (Cool) to Nevada County Line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Carson Creek Bridge to Ray Lawyer overcrossing: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp restrictions from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through (Saturday 10 a.m.)Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to install k-rail and do roadway excavation, grinding and paving work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Sawmill undercrossing (Cedar Grove) to South Fork American River: Motorists can expect alternating east and westbound lane restrictions and **ramp closures** from **6 a.m. to 7p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do shoulder.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Sand Flat Campground to 34 Mile Stone Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound left and right shoulder work from **4 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Wrights Lake Road to Forni tract: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday)**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

**U.S. Highway 50** (El Dorado County) from Pyramid Creek tract to Sierra Ski Ranch Road (Sierra at Tahoe): Motorists can expect east and westbound left and right shoulder work from **4 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday (10 a.m. Friday)**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

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**State Route 89** (El Dorado County) from Scenic Drive to General Creek State Park: Motorists can expect #1 restriction from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work.

**State Route 89** (Placer County) from Grimsel Pass Road to Fern Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

**State Route 89** (Placer County) from Truckee River Bridge to Cabin Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to clean ditches.

**State Route 193** (El Dorado County) from Summer Star / Armes Lane to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

**State Route 267** (Placer County) from Brockway Summit to Northstar Drive to: Motorists can expect #1 and right shoulder restrictions from **6 p.m. to 1 p.m. Sunday through (10 a.m. Friday) Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
