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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday July 22 – July 28, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012.

<u> July 22 – July 27</u>

On Highway 49 from Little Valley Road to Cornette Way: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. (8 a.m. Saturday) Sunday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$167 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013.

<u>July 24 - 29</u>

On westbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various westbound lane and ramp closures from **11 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday through Sunday**. <u>Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-</u>





foot lane 10 p.m. Tuesday through 9 a.m. Sunday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

<u>July 22 - 26</u>

On eastbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 10 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.** <u>Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to one 11-</u><u>foot lane 9 p.m. Sunday through 10 a.m. Friday</u>. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Rex Reservoir undercrossing to the Placer County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sweeping work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bank Street to Coyote Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Saturday. A contractor is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to Bank Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do shoulder work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Cattle Drive to Penn Valley Drive/Rough & Ready Highway: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Saturday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

State Route 20 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Washington Road to Lake
Spaulding Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from
7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do shoulder work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to Bear River
Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 7 a.m. to
4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans Crew is scheduled to do
miscellaneous maintenance work.





State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Bear River to the Yuba County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans Crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Marysville Road to Belle: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Downieville to Sierra City: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 6 a.m. Monday through 5 a.m. Saturday. A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Donner Park overcrossing to the Truckee River: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Union Mills to Boca: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 p.m. Monday through 10 a.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Gold Run to the State Route 193: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Rocklin Road to State Route 193: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Prosser Dam Road/Alder Drive to Hobart Mills Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4:30 Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to clear ditches.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Squaw Valley Road to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 7 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work. <u>Motorists</u> <u>can expect delays of approximately 30 minutes.</u>





State Route 89 (Sierra County) from Sage Hen Creek to State Route 49: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **5 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

State Route 174 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Race Street in Grass Valley to Interstate 80 in Colfax: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. from 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. Caltrans crews are scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Main Street to Sierra College Boulevard: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 a.m. from 2 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
