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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday August 26 – September 1, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right- turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by fall 2012.

August 20 – August 24

On Highway 49 from Little Valley Road to Cornette Way: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. <u>Motorists are reminded that this construction zone is</u> <u>posted at 55 mph and is a no passing zone.</u>

August 21 – October 15

On westbound Interstate 80, all through passage vehicles will be detoured on to a single lane on the eastbound side of Interstate 80. All commercial, large vehicle or vehicles towing will stay on the single remaining lane on the westbound side. **Motorists are**





advised to use caution in the area. Make you lane choice in advance of Nyack to avoid last minute lane changes.

August 21 - August 25

On westbound Interstate 80 from Rainbow to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various westbound lane and ramp closures from **11 p.m. to 9 a.m. Tuesday through Saturday**. <u>*Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to two 11-foot lanes.*</u> A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

August 20 – August 23

On eastbound Interstate 80 from Yuba Gap to Rainbow: Motorists can expect various eastbound lane and ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Thursday.** <u>Motorists can also expect traffic to be shifted to two 11-foot lanes</u>. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Yuba County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Bennett Street to State Route 174: Motorists can expect intermittent lane closures from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Thursday and Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 to Bear River
Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 7 a.m. to
4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans Crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to the Yuba County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans Crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to Dry Creek Road: Motorists can expect intermittent north and southbound #2 lane closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.





State Route 49 (Placer County) from the South Fork Dry Creek to the North Fork Dry Creek: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Downieville to Sierra City: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls at various locations from 6 a.m. Monday through 5 p.m.Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Sierra and Nevada Counties) from the Nevada State line to Boca: Motorists can expect the westbound #2 closed from **7:30 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sweeping operations.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Trout Creek to Donner Lake: Motorists can expect the westbound #3 lane closed from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do shoulder work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at State Route 267/State Route 89N: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **4 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at Boca: Motorists can expect various westbound lane and ramp closures from **6 p.m. Monday to 9 a.m. Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Nyack to the State Route 193: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Rocklin Road to State Route 193: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from **8 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do striping work.

State Route 89 (Nevada County) from Rainbow Drive to Hobart Mills Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch cleaning.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Squaw Valley Road to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 7 p.m. to 10 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work. <u>Motorists</u> <u>can expect delays of approximately 30 minutes.</u>





State Route 89 (Sierra County) from the Nevada County line to Old Truckee Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do paving operations.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Nevada County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 174 (Nevada and Placer Counties) from Rollins Lake Road to Lower Colfax Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from Main Street to Gold Hill Road in Newcastle: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday and 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
