Sunday through Saturday November 25 – December 1, 2012

<u>Most traffic interfering work will be limited Wednesday, November 21</u> through Sunday, November 25 due to the Thanksgiving Holiday

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right-turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by spring 2013. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. *No traffic interfering work is scheduled.*

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Nevada City to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.





State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Hammonton Smartsville Road to Penn Valley Drive (east end) Rough & Ready Highway: Motorists can expect east and westbound right shoulder restrictions from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. AT&T is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Mooney Flat Road to Bowman Lake Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound #2 lanes restrictions from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer County) from the Bear River Bridge to State Route 193 in Cool: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Alta Sierra Drive to Norambgua Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and from 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding, paving and miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from the Placer/Nevada County line to Donner Lake Interchange: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do striping work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from Highway 80/89 separator to Floriston: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane and shoulder closures from **midnight Sunday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at the State Route 20 junction: Motorists can expect westbound ramp closure from **6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Emigrant Gap to Cisco Grove: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound #2 lane closures from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Yuba Gap to Kingvale: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.



Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Atlantic Street to Eureka Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday through Friday.** A contractor crew is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Alpine Meadows Road to West River Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls with up to 10 minutes delay from **4 a.m. to 10 a.m. and from 6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to do sign work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Nevada County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) at Airport Road/Schaffer: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls with up to 10 minute delays from **3 a.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Friday and 7 p.m. to 11 a.m. Friday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to do sign work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
