Good Morning Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders! Welcome to the 2012/13 Winter Snowsports Season. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Wednesday, November 14th. This past weekend's snow blanketed the High Sierra with Fresh Snow and cold temperatures have allowed resort to make snow and has prompted several resorts to open earlier than originally scheduled. Expect Mostly Cloudy Skies with temps into the upper 40's and Light Winds. There is a chance of more snow coming thru starting Thursday night and thru the weekend. Dress in layers, with your Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Sunglasses or Goggles. Surface conditions are Variable but primarily Machine Groomed - Machine Made Snow. Ski & Ride with Care! Early Season Conditions Exist! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles & Stay on Opened Runs Only.

South Lake Tahoe & Surrounding Area Resorts

*Heavenly Mountain Resort - South Lake Tahoe CA/NV 14-17" of natural snow & their massive snow making has allow them to open today. They report a packed base of 18". 2 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4) with Access to the mountain from the Heavenly Village Gondola.
