Good Morning Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders! Welcome to the 2012/13 Winter Snowsports Season. Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Saturday, November 17th. More Unsettled weather with a Winter Weather Advisory now posted from 4pm today thru 10am tomorrow above 6500 feet. Rain and Snow expected today with Snow Level 7000 to 7500 feet, with 3-6" predicted above 7000 feet. Temps will be warming, into the low 40's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate winds with possible Ridge gusts up to 90 mph that may hamper the operation of upper mountain lifts. Dress in layers, with your windproof – waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are Variable but primarily Machine Groomed - Machine Made Snow with fresh snow on top. Ski & Ride with Care! Early Season Conditions Exist! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles & Stay on Opened Runs Only.
