Expect Mostly Cloudy Skies with Temps into the mid 40's on the Slopes and Light to Moderate winds with possible Ridge gusts up to 50 mph that may hamper the operation of upper mountain lifts. So, upper mountain lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Dress in layers, with your windproof – waterproof Jacket. Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are Variable but primarily Machine Groomed - Machine Made Snow with Fresh Snow on top. Ski & Ride with Care! Early Season Conditions Exist! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles & Stay on Opened Runs Only.

*Heavenly Mountain Resort - South Lake Tahoe CA/NV – Checks in reporting 1" of new (7-8" Storm total) on a base of 18-24". 3 Lifts are scheduled to operate (9-4)-WWP, with Access to the mountain from the Heavenly Village Gondola with Tamarack Express & Dipper Express turning on the upper mountain. 3 runs are open including Orion's Run, plus 7 Terrain Park Features.
