SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday December 9 – December 15, 2012

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right-turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by spring 2013. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. *No traffic interfering work is scheduled.*

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Rex Reservoir undercrossing to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer County) from the Bear River Bridge to State Route 193 in Cool: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.





State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Alta Sierra Drive to Norambgua Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding, paving and miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Live Oak Lane to Luther Road: Motorists can expect intermittent full highway closures from **5 a.m. to 10 a.m. Sunday**. A contractor is scheduled to do overhead utility work. **Delays will not exceed 20 minutes**.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at Donner Park: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures on the overcrossing from **9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do grinding work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) from State Route 89 to the Truckee River: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane closures from **midnight Monday through noon Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at State Route 267/State Route 89N: Motorists can expect various westbound lane closures from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at Boca: Motorists can expect full westbound ramp closures from **7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do bridge work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) at Bowman Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **midnight Monday through midnight Friday.** A contractor crew is scheduled to do bridge work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Nevada County line to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect intermittent one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) at Airport Road/Schaffer Mill: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do sign work.





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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
