Scattered Snow Showers then Snow – Heavy at times by late morning. 5-10" expected above 7000 ft. with Temperatures in to the upper 20's on the Slopes and increasing Winds with Gusts to 35mph and Ridge Top Gusts up to 100 mph. So Lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Call Ahead! Dress warm, in layers with your Good Jacket... Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are primarily Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Early Season Conditions Exist! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles & Stay on Opened Runs Only.
