A Winter Storm Warning remains in affect thru 4am on Monday for more Snow. Another 6-16" expected above 7000 ft. with Temperatures in to the mid 20's on the Slopes and Gusty Winds up to 50mph and Ridge Top Gusts up to 85-115 mph. So Lifts will operate Wind & Weather Permitting. Call Ahead! Dress warm, in layers with your Good Jacket... Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are primarily Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Early Season Conditions Exist! Keep an Eye for Marked and Unmarked Obstacles & Stay on Opened Runs Only and if go Off Piste, always Ski with a Buddy.
