Merry Christmas & Happy Holidays, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders! Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your Christmas Day, Tuesday, December 25th. Get Out and enjoy some the Best Holiday Skiing & Riding Conditions offered in years... Expect increasing Cloudy Skies with a Chance of Snow in the afternoon as a Winter Weather Advisory is posted to go in effect at 4pm. Temperatures in to the high 20's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds increasing to 55mph over the ridge tops by the afternoon. So Winds could affect Lifts, later in the day. Another 10-18" expected to fall above 7000 feet by tomorrow afternoon. For today, Dress warm, in layers with your Good Jacket... Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Have Patience in Lift Lines, Please Slow Down and watch out for the other guy! Keep an Eye out for Marked & Unmarked Obstacles. And, Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs Only and if go Off-Piste, always Ski & Ride with a Buddy.
