Happy Holidays, Lake Tahoe Skiers & Riders! Here's your Mountain Resort Report for your, Wednesday, December 26th. A Winter Weather Advisory is in effect thru 4pm for More Snow with 4-7" expected above 7000 feet. Temperatures remain cold, in to the mid 20's on the Slopes with Light to Moderate Winds and 80 mph Gusts over the ridge tops this morning, decreasing to 55 mph, by the afternoon. So Winds could affect the operation of upper mountain lifts. Call Ahead. Dress warm... layer up with your Good Jacket & Warm Gloves... Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Have Patience in Lift Lines. Keep an Eye out for Marked & Unmarked Obstacles. And, Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs & Terrain Only; and if go Off-Piste, always Ski & Ride with a Buddy.
