Expect Mostly Cloudy skies with Temperatures in to the mid 20's on the Slopes with Light Winds. Dress warm... layer up with your Insulated Jacket & Warm Gloves... Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear Good Goggles today. Surface conditions are Powder, Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder. Ski & Ride with Care! Have Patience in Lift Lines. Keep an Eye out for Marked & Unmarked Obstacles. And, Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs & Terrain Only; and if go Off-Piste, always Ski & Ride with a Buddy.
