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SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE Sunday through Saturday January 13, 2012 – January 19, 2013

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Highway 49 (Nevada County) Work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, right-turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected by spring 2013. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in the fall of 2013. **No traffic interfering work is scheduled.**

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Placer County) from Bank Street to Bennett Street: Motorists can expect the east and westbound #2 lanes closed from **9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do shoulder work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer County) from the Bear River Bridge to State Route 193 in Cool: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.





State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Alta Sierra Drive to Norambqua Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from the North Yuba River Bridge to Union Flat Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Ladies Canyon to Union Flat Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the Weimar to Heather Glen: Motorists can expect intermittent full highway closures from **5 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. Sunday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work. **Expect delays of approximately 15 minutes.**

State Route 89 (Placer County) at the Silver Creek Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) at Cabin Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) at West River Street: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from Interstate 80 to the Nevada County line: Motorist can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) at Airport Road/Schaffer Mill Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do electrical work.





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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
