There's Some Fresh Powder reported at some resorts & a Chance of Snow expected to continue today with another 3-6" possible to fall above 7000 Feet. Temperatures will be staying cool, only in to the mid 20's on the Slopes with Light Winds. Dress warm, in layers with your insulated Jacket... Wear a Hat, Beanie or Wear a Helmet for Safety; also, wear warm gloves and Good Goggles. Surface conditions are Machine Groomed & Skier/Rider Packed Powder with some Powder on top. Ski & Ride with Care! Keep an Eye out for Marked & Unmarked Obstacles. And, Stay In Bounds and on Opened Runs & Terrain Only; And, if go Off-Piste, always Ski & Ride with a Buddy.
