El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday March 17-23, 2013

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

U. S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Sacramento County line to Bass Lake Road: Work continues on a \$31 million project by El Dorado County adding bus/carpool lanes to U. S. Highway 50 in south El Dorado County. The westbound carpool lane from Cameron Park Drive to Bass Lake Road remains closed because of a drainage problem in one section of the lane. The contractor will repave that section when weather allows, likely in early May.

March 17-23

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from the Carson Creek Bridge to Ponderosa Road: Motorists can expect lane restrictions and off-ramp closures from **7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Sunday to Monday**, **7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday** and from **8 p.m. to 9 a.m. Friday to Saturday**. A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work continues on a \$40.6 million project that has widened shoulders, constructed new sidewalks, added bike lanes and installed new roadside drainage systems from Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Boulevard. Landscaping is scheduled for spring 2013. Completion is expected in summer 2013. **Project is in winter suspension.**



State Route 89 (Placer County): Work is scheduled to resume in May on a \$34 million project to rehabilitate stormwater drainage and treatment systems, realign the road, and widen shoulders to allow bicycles and places for cars to pull out of traffic from Tahoe City to Tahoma. Completion is expected in 2016. **Project is in winter suspension.**

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer counties) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) from just north of Camelian Wood Avenue to Commonwealth/Kingswood Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls **from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do crack sealing work.
