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El Dorado County / Tahoe Roadwork Schedule Sunday through Saturday June 2-8, 2013

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 89 (Placer County): Work continues on a \$41 million project from Tahoe City to Tahoma on Lake Tahoe's West Shore that will upgrade stormwater drainage and treatment systems, add curbs and gutters, resurface and realign the road and widen shoulders to allow for bicycles and places for vehicles to pull out of traffic. Sections of the bike trail will also be revamped. Completion is expected in 2016.

June 2-8

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Grand Avenue to Sugar Pine Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control at various locations around the clock from **11 p.m. Sunday until noon Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 28 (Placer County): Work continues on Placer County's \$31 million Kings Beach Commercial Core Improvement Project from Route 267 to Chipmunk Avenue. The project will install curbs, sidewalks, roundabouts and drainage to enhance pedestrian/bicycle mobility, improve safety and provide water-quality improvements.

June 2-8

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Beach Street to Coon Street: Eastbound motorists can expect the #2 lane and shoulder closed around the clock from **midnight Sunday until 11 p.m. Thursday**. Westbound motorists can expect the

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#2 lane closed from National Avenue to Agatam Avenue and from Secline Street to Deer Street from **8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work continues on completing a \$43 million project from the Trout Creek Bridge to Ski Run Boulevard. Landscaping, striping and electrical work is scheduled for spring and summer 2013. Completion is expected in late summer or early fall.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) in South Lake Tahoe: Work has started on a \$7.3 project from just west of Ski Run Boulevard to Wildwood Avenue adding curbs and gutters, new drainage systems and resurfacing. Completion is expected by 2014.

June 2-8

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Fairway Avenue to Wildwood Avenue: Eastbound motorists can expect alternating lane and shoulder restrictions from **6 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday** and from **midnight to noon Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Pine Avenue to the Truckee River Bridge in Tahoe City: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do shoulder work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) at Alpine Meadows Road and at Pole Creek Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **4 a.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do sign work.

State Route 28 (Placer County) from Dollar Hill to Chinquapin Drive: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday and Tuesday**. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 267 (Placer County) at Airport Road/ Schaffer Mill Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **4 a.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do sign work.

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at Sand Flat Campground: Eastbound motorists can expect alternating lane restrictions from **4 a.m. to 3 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do sign work.





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U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) at 34 Mile Stone Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **4 a.m. to 10 a.m. Monday through Friday**. A contractor is scheduled to do sign work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado/Placer County) from the junction of State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic control from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do maintenance work.

SPECIAL EVENTS

State Route 89 (El Dorado County) from Spring Creek Road to Vikingsholm Vista Point: Motorists can expect the northbound lane closed from **6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Sunday** during “America’s Most Beautiful Bike Ride.”

U.S. Highway 50 (El Dorado County) from Zephyr Cove, Nevada, to Placerville: Motorists can expect to share the road from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday through Saturday** with the Highway 50 Association Wagon Train.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above.

Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.). Unexpected schedule changes may occur.
