SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE
Sunday through Saturday
July 28, 2013 – Aug. 3, 2013

*Due to the "Hot August Nights" event in Reno, lane closures on Interstate 80 and State Route 20 from Nevada City to the 20/80 junction will not be allowed during the following days and hours:

- **Eastbound from Thursday at noon to Sunday 8 p.m.**
- **Westbound from Friday at 10 a.m. to Monday at 8 p.m.**

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Nevada County) work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, adding right-turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected in August 2013.

July 28-Aug. 3

No traffic-interfering work is scheduled.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in October of 2013.

July 28-Aug. 3

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) from Cisco Grove to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **Midnight**





Monday through 10 a.m. Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work. **No two consecutive ramps will be closed at a time to allow for local access.**

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from the Placer County line to Cameo Drive: Southbound motorists can expect the #2 lane closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from Nevada Street to Palm Avenue: Southbound motorists can expect the # 2 lane closed from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (Placer County) from North Fork Dry Creek to Joeger Road: Southbound motorists can expect #2 lane and shoulder restrictions from **8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Main Street in Downieville to Nevada Drive in Sierra City: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada County) at Farad Street: Eastbound motorists can the #2 lane closed from **7:45 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Tuesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guardrail repair work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from the junction of State Route 193 in Newcastle to Gold Run Road: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **7 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Nevada County line to Interstate 80: Motorist can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. Monday through Wednesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.





State Route 193 (Placer County) from Sierra College Boulevard to Rainbow Valley Lane: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls **from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do tree work.

State Route 89 (Sierra County) from the junction of State Route 49 in Sierraville to Main Street in Calpine: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do shoulder work.

The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
