SIERRA ROADWORK SCHEDULE

Sunday through Saturday August 25, 2013 – August 31, 2013

Most traffic interfering work will be limited from Friday, August 30 through Monday, September 2 for the Labor Day Weekend.

LONG-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (Nevada County) work has resumed on the \$29 million Highway 49/La Barr Meadows Project that will widen State Route 49 to four lanes between Little Valley Road and Norambagua Way, just south of Grass Valley. The project includes a signalized intersection at La Barr Meadows Road, widening of shoulders, adding right-turn pockets and new sound walls. Completion is expected in August 2013.

August 25 - 29

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Alta Sierra to Norambgua Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in October of 2013.

August 26 - 29



Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) from Cisco Grove to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from Midnight Monday through noon Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at a time to allow for local access.

July 30 - September 13

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) from just east of Cisco Grove: Motorists can expect split traffic lanes from July 30 through September 13. A contractor is scheduled to do finish bridge deck work. <u>Motorists are encouraged to limit unnecessary lane changes when approaching the area.</u>

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Chalk Bluff Road to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A contractor is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Pet Hill to Uren Street: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane and ramp closures from 5 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to grinding and paving work. <u>No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time to allow for motorist access.</u>

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from the State Route 49/20 junction to Gold Flat Road: Motorists can expect east and westbound lane and ramp closures on and near bridge structures from **7 p.m. to 8 a.m. Monday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to bridge deck work. **No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time to allow for motorist access.**

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Chalk Bluff Road to White Cloud Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Wednesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do guardrail work.

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Excelsior Road to Interstate 80: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday and Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.



State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Cedar Song Road to Star Lumber: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 49 (Nevada County) from Oak Tree Road to the Middle Fork American River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do pavement work.

State Route 49 (Sierra County) from Coyoteville to Sierra Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do ditch work.

Interstate 80 (Nevada and Sierra Counties) from Kingvale to the Nevada State line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from Gold Run to the Nevada County line: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from **6 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

Interstate 80 (Placer County) from State Route 193 to Gold Run: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 89 (Placer County) from Silver Creek Campground to Goose Meadows Campground: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Thursday**. A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do drainage work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Nevada County line to Interstate 80: Motorist can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.

State Route 174 (Placer County) from the Nevada County line to Main Street in Marysville: Motorist can expect one-way traffic controls in various locations from **6 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday through Thursday.** A contractor is scheduled to do paving work.

State Route 193 (Placer County) from the Newcastle Tunnel to Gold Hill Road: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through**



Thursday and 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility and tree work.

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The Caltrans District Traffic Management Branch has reviewed each project and determined that individual project delays are expected to be less than the statewide policy maximum of 30 minutes, unless noted otherwise above. Lanes are numbered from the center divide (#1) to the shoulder (#2, 3, 4, etc.).
