LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in October of 2013.

October 13 – October 18

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) from Cisco Grove to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane and ramp closures from 10 p.m. Sunday through noon Friday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at a time to allow for local access.

October 13 – October 18

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) at Rainbow Road: Motorists can expect a full eastbound detour from **5 p.m. Sunday through 10 a.m. Friday.** A contractor is scheduled to do emergency culvert replacement work.

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 20 (Nevada County) from Pet Hill to Uren Street: Motorists can expect intermittent east and westbound lane and ramp closures from **5 p.m. to 8 a.m. Sunday through Saturday.** A contractor is scheduled to do grinding and paving work. **No two consecutive ramps will be closed at one time to allow for motorist access.**



State Route 20 (Nevada and Yuba Counties) from Mooney Flat Road to Upper Smartsville Road: Motorists can expect the eastbound bound #2 lane closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday. A contractor is scheduled to do utility work.
