LONG-TERM PROJECTS

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada Counties) from Carpenter Flat to Hampshire Rock: Work continues on the \$105 million Emigrant Gap project on Interstate 80. Work includes total roadway replacement with Portland Cement Concrete, improving the drainage systems and installing new sediment/debris collection systems. Completion is expected in November of 2013.

Interstate 80 (Placer and Nevada County) from Cisco Grove to Yuba Gap: Motorists can expect various east and westbound lane closures from 10 p.m. Sunday through 6 p.m. Tuesday. A contractor is scheduled to do miscellaneous construction work

SHORT-TERM PROJECTS

State Route 49 (El Dorado and Placer Counties) from State Route 193 in Cool to the Bear River Bridge: Motorists can expect one-way traffic controls from **8 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. Monday and Tuesday.** A Caltrans crew is scheduled to do miscellaneous maintenance work.
